

## Bulb Cage

Now you can plant your favorite bulbs without worrying that they'll be eaten. The Bulb Cage is made of heavy gauge steel wire to protect your bulbs from burrowing animals such as mice, squirrels and voles.

If you have a large rodent population, we recommend using Bulb Insurance to protect bulbs planted outside the cages. Made from coarsely-ground oyster shells, Bulb Insurance forms a sharp-edged barrier that burrowing rodents will think twice before crossing.

### Assembly Instructions

1. Unfold the panels and lay them flat on the ground.
2. Refold the panels to make a 12" by 12" square cage, 5" high. Connect the sides by snapping the wires into the connectors.

### Prepare the ground

3. Dig a hole a little more than 12" square. The depth of the hole depends on the bulbs you are planting. Refer to the planting instructions for your bulbs to determine how deep they should be planted and how far apart they should be spaced.

4. Set the cage in the bottom of the hole and lift the top panel. Fill the cage with soil to the proper planting depth for the bulbs. If you are using fertilizer, mix it into the soil now.

5. Set the bulbs on the soil with the roots down and cover them with soil to the top of the cage. Gently firm the soil.

6. Snap the top panel door into place. Cover the cage with the remaining soil and water thoroughly.
