

Chelsea Arbor

The Chelsea Arbor is a perfect way to define the entrance to your garden and is strong enough for hardy climbing roses. Vines such as clematis or morning glories look great climbing up the sides, and you can add the curved Gate to create the effect of an appealing “keyhole” window. Optional “Wings” provide additional structure, and Fence Panels (offered below) can also be added to complete the look.

Assembly Instructions

Parts Included:

- 1 Right Side Panel (note stabilizing feet should face inside arch when assembled)
- 1 Left Side Panel (note stabilizing feet should face inside arch when assembled)
- 2 Arch Pieces with flat plate bent towards right
- 2 Arch Pieces with flat plate bent towards left
- 1 Center Arch Crosspiece with attached keystone
- 4 Arch crosspieces

Hardware Included:

- 2 Wrenches
- 2 Bolts with Nuts
- 4 Metal Stakes for stabilizer feet

Tools Needed: A mallet or hammer may be needed to drive metal stabilizer stakes into ground if the soil is dry or hard.

Step 1. For easier assembly, assemble on site.

Step 2. Lay the right side Arch Pieces on the ground with the flat connecting plate and holes facing upward.

Step 3. Insert 2 top Arch Crosspieces into the two holes in that Arch Piece.

Step 4. Lay the corresponding Arch Front on top of Crosspieces with the flat plate bent toward the ground.

Step 5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to assembly the left side of the Arch.

Step 6. Connect the two sides of arch with the Center Arch Crosspiece using the bolts provided. Hand tighten only at this time.

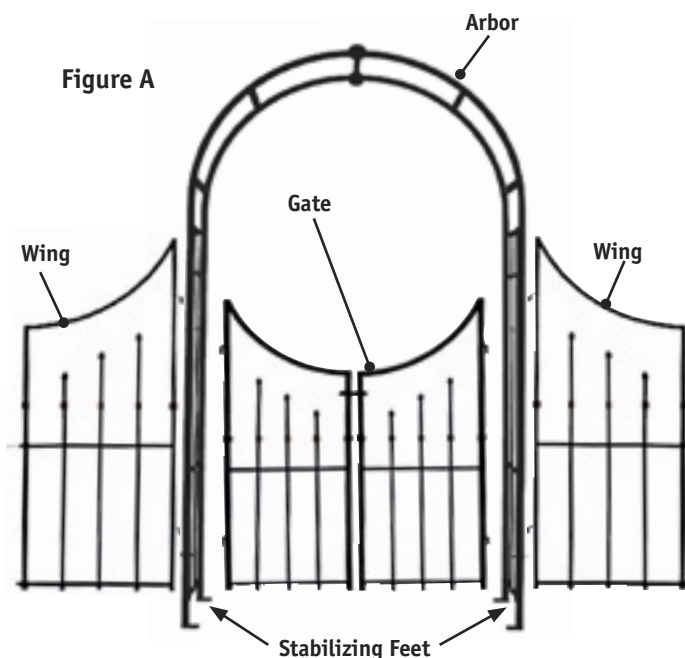
Step 7. With the Arch still on the ground, slide the Left and Right Side Panels of the Arch into the top Arch Piece. Make sure the Stabilizing Feet are facing inside the Arch.

Step 8. Fully tighten the bolts with the 2 wrenches provided.

Step 9. Measure the width at the top of the Side Panels and compare to the width at the bottom of the Panels to insure the sides are parallel when the Arbor is vertical. Hold the top of the Arch at the Center Crossbar to lift it off the ground. Carefully walk the piece to a vertical position.

Step 10. Insert the Stakes into the Stabilizer Feet. If necessary, use a hammer or mallet to drive the stakes fully into the ground.

NOTE: If you are adding Wings to the Arbor, attach the two Angle Brackets to each Side of the Arbor, using the bolts and nuts provided. You will find the predrilled holes in the Panels where you are to install the Brackets. Next, slide the Pins located on each Wing into the Brackets. The Assembly is now complete and your Arbor is ready to use.
