

Window Mirror

This Trompe L'Oeil window is a fun visual trick and will add a new dimension to your garden. Trompe L'Oeil is a French term which means *that which deceives the eye*. The French term was first applied to realistic still life paintings in the 18th Century. Trompe L'Oeil is used today to describe almost any kind of technique that fools one into perceiving a one-dimensional image as three-dimensional.

Mounting Instructions

The Window Mirror is made of unbreakable reflective acrylic and has a pine frame. It comes with brackets and wood screws for hanging on the side of a barn, shed, storage building or other surface.

If you would like to hang it on a surface other than wood, you will need to provide the appropriate screws for hanging on the surface.

If you would like to treat the wood before mounting, we recommend using an oil-based paint or sealant made specifically for soft woods. Be sure the finish is completely dry before exposing the Window Mirror to sun or moisture.

Note: The Window Mirror weighs approximately 10 lbs.
