

Hi-Rise Sprinkler

The Hi-Rise Sprinkler attaches to a standard garden hose. When fully assembled, it stands five feet high. The water spray simulates a gentle rain and can reach to thirty feet in diameter. The only tool you'll need for assembly is an adjustable wrench.

The Copper Sprinkler includes the following parts:

- Tube with Sprinkler
- Anchoring Spike

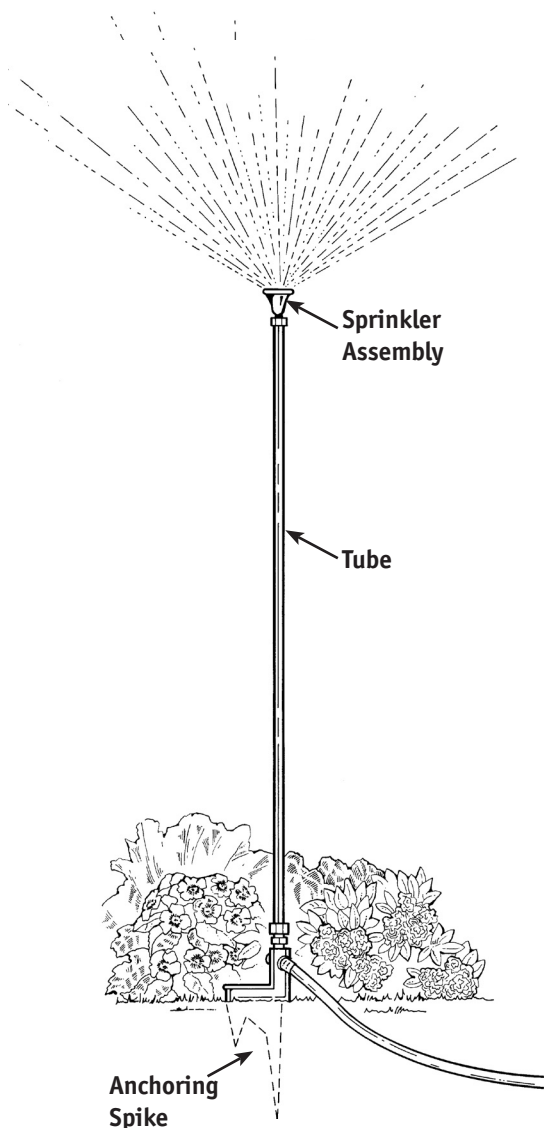
Assembly Instructions

Step 1. Carefully screw the Tube (with attached Sprinkler Assembly) into the Anchoring Spike and firmly tighten with an adjustable wrench.

Step 2. Attach a garden hose to the hose connector on the Spike.

Step 3. Locate an area in your yard or garden where the soil is firm. Push the Spike into the ground with your foot using the foot pad on the Spike. Hold the Tube as straight as possible as you push the Spike into the ground.

Note: If the ground is not firm, or if you make adjustments to the Anchoring Spike, the sprinkler may not be straight. In either case, take out the Spike and push

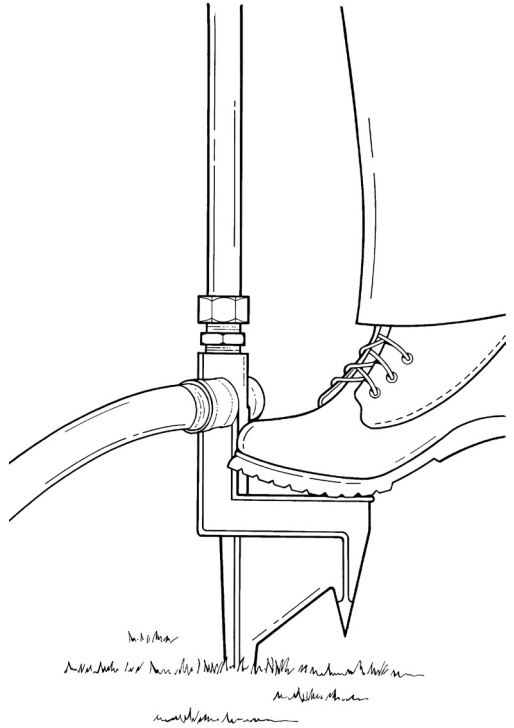


it into a new location in the ground until it is stable.

Step 4. To operate the Sprinkler, simply turn the water on or off.

Storage Information

Do not leave the Sprinkler outdoors in freezing temperatures. Freezing water trapped inside can split the Tube and Sprinkler Assembly.
