

## Forever Raised Bed

Raised garden beds are the easiest way to grow your own fresh vegetables. Our new Forever Raised Beds set up in minutes and last for decades. Made from a composite of recycled wood and plastic, they have the attractive look and feel of silvery aged cedar, but will not splinter or rot.

These assembly instructions are for the 3' x 3' and 3' x 6' Forever Raised Beds.

### Assembly Instructions

**Tools needed: drill and level.**

**The 3' x 3' Raised Bed includes the following parts:**

- (4) 3' Sides
- (4) Angle Brackets
- (4) Side Braces
- (16) 3/4" Phillips screws

**The 3' x 6' Raised Bed includes the following parts:**

- (2) 3' Sides
- (2) 6' Sides
- (4) Angle Brackets
- (6) Side Braces
- (16) 3/4" Phillips screws

1. Choose a location in your yard or garden that is appropriate for the type of plants you will be growing in your raised bed. Clear the site of sod and weeds and make it as level as possible.

2. Find the Angle Brackets attached to the inside of the Raised Bed Sides. (See the back of this bulletin for a diagram.)

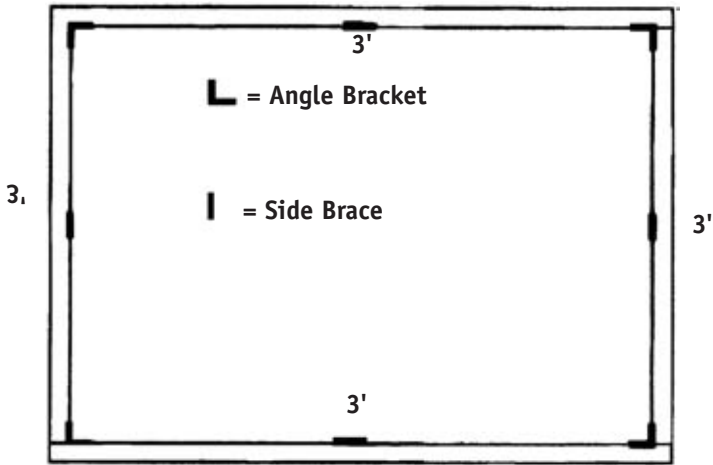
There is one edge of the Angle Bracket that is flush with the bottom edge of the Side. Place that Side edge on the ground.

3. Attach the 3' sides to the Angle Brackets by placing the screws through the pre-drilled holes in the Angle Brackets. Tighten the screws using a drill. Be sure the screws enter straight and not at an angle.

4. Repeat Steps 2 and 3 to attach the other 3' Side to the Angle Brackets (using 4 screws per corner).

5. Place the assembled bed in the site you have cleared and fill it with soil. We recommend mixing in plenty of organic matter such as aged manure or compost. You are now ready to begin planting!
