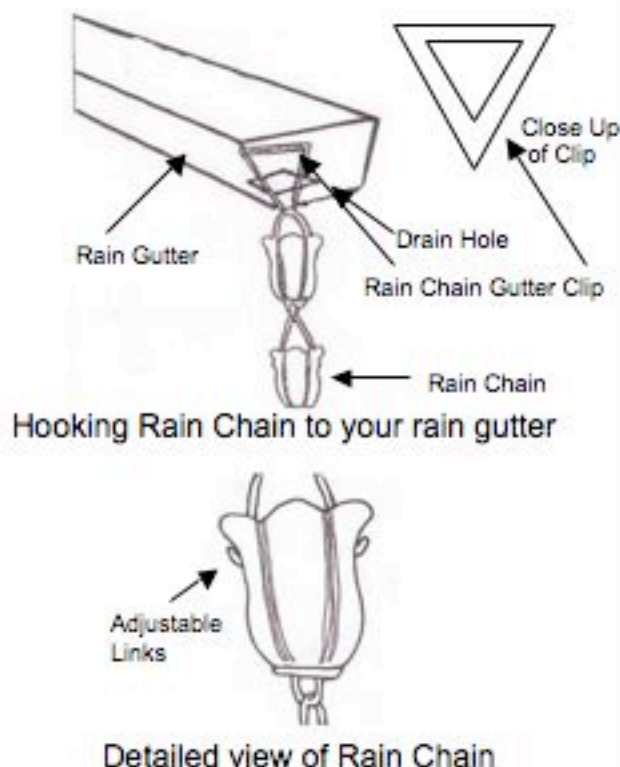


4' Lotus Rain Chain

Model #: 37-974

Parts Included*:

- 10 Rain Funnels
- 1 Gutter Clip
- 48" Long
- Adjustable Height



INSTALLING YOUR RAIN CHAIN (Tools Required – Not Included)

1. First, remove the downspout on your rain gutter. The gutter clip is designed to sit in the rain gutter over the drain hole where the downspout was and helps direct the water flow onto the chain.
2. Installation may require some slight bending of the Rain Chain gutter clip, so that it sits correctly in the gutter. The gutter clip should bend easily by hand or with pliers. From the bottom of the drain hole, push the Rain Chain up through the hole. Bend it so that it fits onto your rain gutter drain hole.
3. The main tip of the gutter clip should be pointing straight down to the ground. It will look like an upside down triangle sitting in the rain gutter drain hole.

INSTALLATION & USAGE TIPS

- Use a rain gutter screen to prevent debris and leaves from entering your Rain Chain.
- Over time, copper will gain a wonderful natural Verdigris Patina.

TO SHORTEN RAIN CHAIN:

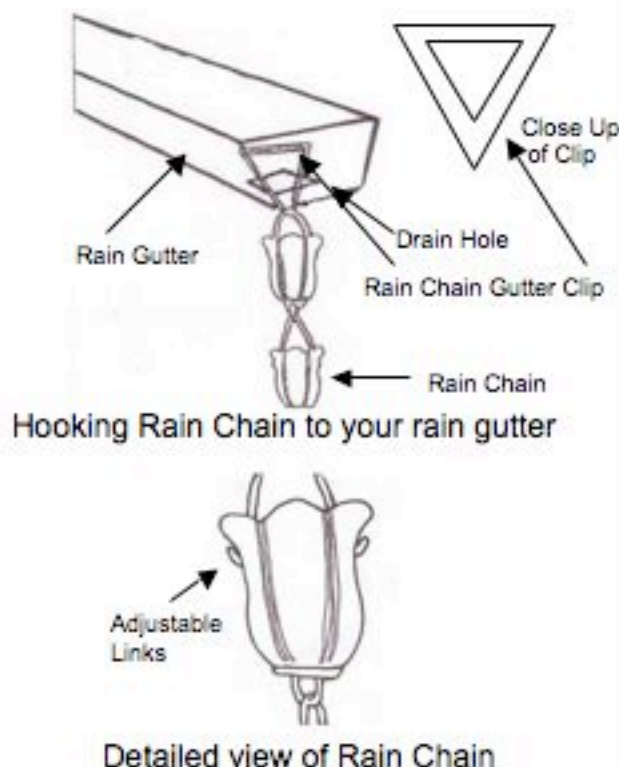
1. Decide how short you would like the Rain Chain to be.
2. To remove the piece, carefully unbend the two adjustment links on either side of the Rain Chain link you wish to remove.

- 20 Rain Funnels
- 1 Gutter Clip
- 96" Long
- Adjustable Height



INSTALLING YOUR RAIN CHAIN (Tools Required – Not Included)

1. First, remove the downspout on your rain gutter. The gutter clip is designed to sit in the rain gutter over the drain hole where the downspout was and helps direct the water flow onto the chain.
2. Installation may require some slight bending of the Rain Chain gutter clip, so that it sits correctly in the gutter. The gutter clip should bend easily by hand or with pliers.
