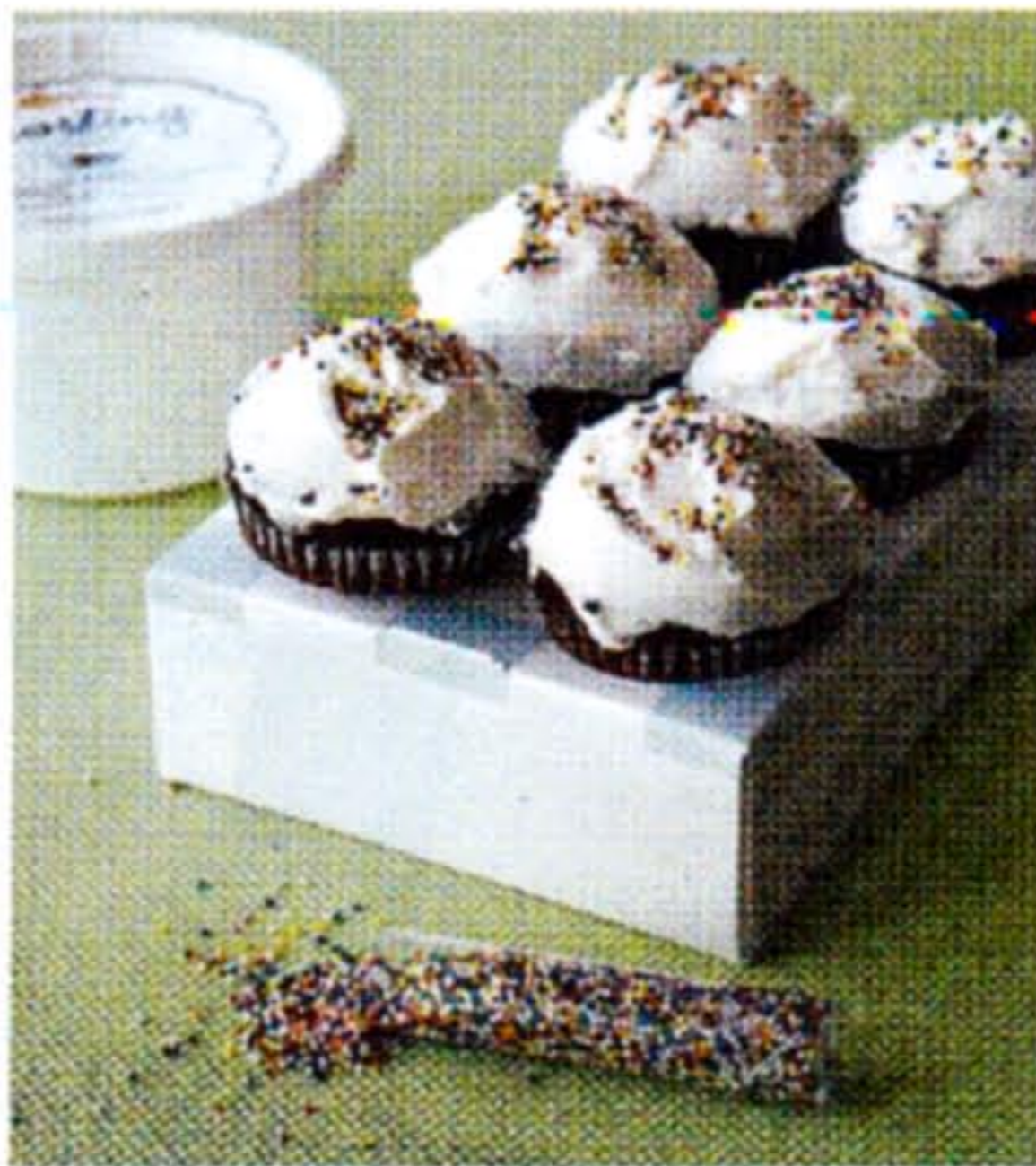
## Perfect pair
