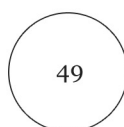
**USAGE:**

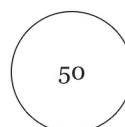
- ▶ 1. Use a ring (such as a wedding band) worn on the same finger and on the same hand as the one you intend to wear the new ring on.
- ▶ 2. Place your ring over the circles below in order to identify the one that best corresponds to the size of your finger. The diameter of the circle must be accurately fitted to the interior diameter of the ring, while leaving the outline of the circle visible.
- ▶ 3. If the ring is in between two sizes, choose the larger size.
