teacher's pencil & apple mason jar



SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Gloss Enamels:
 - White
 - Dark Chocolate
 - Black
 - Bright Yellow
 - Razzle Berry
- Decou-page matte
- Glass paint marker – Silver
- Mason jar
- Brushes liner, #8 round
- Paper towel
- Water container
- Palette or plastic plate
- Green string or yarn
- Red & green fabric scraps
- Tape
- Scissors
- Craft glue
- Rubbing alcohol

DIRECTIONS:

1. Wipe mason jar and lid clean with rubbing alcohol.
2. Trace pencil pattern (4) cut and tape to inside of Mason jar.
3. Using #8 brush paint in bright yellow, top (wood part) in light brown (2 parts white – 1 part dark chocolate).
4. Use silver paint marker to paint pencil's ferrule.
5. Using #8 brush paint eraser in Razzle Berry.
6. Using liner brush line pencil and paint lead in black.
7. Trace Apple pattern on Mason jar lid and red fabric and cut.
8. Trace stem and leaf on card stock and green fabric and cut.
9. Decoupage apple piece together and use craft glue to glue stem and leaf.
10. Allow to dry between coats.
