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# Craft with Jo-Ann

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- DCWV® 12"x12" Christmas Memories Stack
- DCWV® 12"x12" Neutrals Cardstock Stack
- Assorted paper mache cones
- Assorted paper doilies
- 1" red beads
- 3" burlap ribbon
- 3/8" burlap ribbon
- Tinsel garland
- 1/2" ivory bias tape
- 1" white lace
- Twine
- White glitter
- Assorted silver bells in various sizes
- Brown ink pad
- Large rhinestones
- Needle & white thread

- Scratch paper
- Craft wire
- Decorative border punch
- 1/8" hole punch
- Scoring tool
- Paper crafting adhesive
- Glitter glue
- Hot glue gun & glue sticks
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Paper trimmer
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Pliers
- Templates: snowflake, pinecones

### DIRECTIONS:

Once all components are complete, hang on garland.

### CONES & BELLS

1. Trim off the pointed end of each cone, leaving a 1/4"-1/2" hole at the top.
2. One at a time, cover the inside of each cone with glue, adding the white glitter just after the glue is applied. Set cones aside to dry.
3. Prepare the doily for each cone. Ink around the edge of the doily. Distress each one by crumpling and/or folding.
4. When the glitter/glue is dry, open doilies back up and adhere around the larger end of each cone with decorative side down, trimming any excess from the middle.
5. Cover the outside of each cone with a different print from the stack, continuing to leave the hole open. Wrap a strip of the tinsel garland around the larger end of each cone. Adhere a strip of the burlap ribbon just above the tinsel garland. Set aside.
6. Cover the outside of each bell with glue. Leave the inside and any holes untouched. Add a layer of glitter. Set aside to dry.
7. Once the glitter/glue is dry, attach each bell (individually) to a length of twine. Cut the twine pieces twice as long

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as the cones or longer.

- Beginning with the first cone, hold the 2 bells (1 small and 1 medium) at the bottom, thread each piece of twine through the top of the cone, pulling the bells up until they reach desired length. Adhere the first piece down the side of the cone until it meets up with the burlap ribbon. Trim any excess. Tie a knot and a loop at the top of the 2nd piece of twine; trim the excess. Wrap the remainder (or cut a new piece if desired) tightly around the top of the cone, covering 3/4"-1" of the tip.
- Repeat until there is a group of 3 cones.
- Attach the grouping together at the top, adding a twine loop to hang them.
- Repeat as needed for any remaining clusters.

### **BOWS:**

- Create a bow with the 3" burlap ribbon. Attach it together with wire, leaving 2 long tails in the back.
- Cut 3 pieces of twine, one each, in increments of 5", 6" and 7". Tie them together in a knot on one end. Adhere the knot to the center of the burlap bow.
- Using 3 of the 1" red beads, cover each with glue and glitter, leaving the area in the center uncovered. Set these aside to dry.
- Distress a small doily using the previous technique. Fold it in half and adhere it to the center of the burlap bow.
- Create a 2" rosette from a print in the stack. Begin by cutting a 2-1/2"x12" strip of printed paper. Trim along both the longer sides with the decorative border punch and then lay the strip on workspace vertically. Make a score line down the middle and then turn the paper horizontally. Beginning on one end, score the paper every 1/4" until reaching the opposite side. Fold the paper back and forth and then lay it horizontally. Pinch the first end together (left side), using the fold in the middle to hold it in place with additional ease. Adhere and/or staple this section together in the back (side opposite the print). Repeat the process for the remaining side. Adhere the rosette to the center of the burlap bow.
- Tie a bow with the bias tape, leaving long tails on both sides. Ink the bow and the tails and then adhere it to the center of the rosette.
- Once the glitter/glue is dry on the beads, attach one to each of the ends of twine, tying a knot at each end to secure them in place.
- Repeat the above steps enough times to create 1 bow for each of the cone groupings.
- Attach one at the top of each grouping and display where desired.

### **FANCY PAPER SNOWFLAKES**

- Remove beige cardstock sheets from the DCWV® neutrals cardstock stack. Cut out desired amount of snowflakes in preferred sizes.
- Create a corresponding rosette for each grouping. Begin by cutting a printed paper strip that fits the width of the inside area of each doily, leaving the length at 12". Lay the strip on work surface vertically and make a score line

down the middle. Turn the paper horizontally and beginning at one end, score the paper every 1/4" until reaching the opposite side. Fold the paper back and forth and then lay it horizontally. Pinch the first end together (left side), using the fold in the middle to hold it in place with additional ease. Adhere and/or staple this section together in the back (side opposite the print). Repeat the process for the remaining side.

- Repeat as needed, creating a rosette for each snowflake/doily grouping.
- Adhere the 3 items together, paper doily on the bottom, rosette in the middle, and the snowflake on top.
- Gather a section of lace together for the center of each grouping. Adhere one to each of the snowflake centers. Top them off with a rhinestone embellishment.

### **PAPER PINECONES**

- Select desired cardstock sheets from the DCWV® neutrals cardstock stack.
- Cut out four of each size using template. Fold along score lines and attach ends in the middle. Layer together to create pinecone.
- Repeat in desired sizes and cardstock colors.
