SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- DCWV® 12"x12" Christmas Memories Stack
- 12"x12" gold glitter cardstock sheet
- 12"x12" green cardstock sheet
- Blue moon beads: 1-2 strands of 3/8" red round beads
- Styrofoam® cone shape form
- Linen thread
- Lace & pearl ribbon
- Self-adhesive pearl embellishments
- Template: star, angel
- Skewer
- 1/8" hole punch
- 2" square paper crafting punch
- Paper crafting adhesive
- Hot glue gun & glue sticks
- Scissors
- Paper trimmer
- Pencil
- Ruler

DIRECTIONS:

STAR CHRISTMAS TREE

1. Select 5 prints from the stack. Punch and/or cut the first 2 sheets into 2"x2" squares, setting the other 3 sheets aside momentarily.
2. Starting with the squares, determine the desired pattern for adhering them to the tree (i.e. alternate the pattern, using one on the first row and another on the 2nd; alternate using both patterns in the same row, etc.). Begin rolling squares into cone shapes, adhering them together to hold the cone in place. Once all cones are ready, adhere them to the Styrofoam® cone.
3. Take the other 2 sheets and cut them into mini-pennants. Punch a hole in each of the top corners and string them, along with beads (1 pennant, 1 bead, 1 pennant, 1 bead, etc.) onto the linen thread. Once desired length is achieved, wrap the banner around the tree, adhering in place as desired.
4. Cut a star from the final print. Adhere to the top of the tree.

ANGEL CHRISTMAS TREE

1. Cover the Styrofoam® tree with the green cardstock. Insert the skewer into the top of the tree, leaving 2" of wood visible at the top.
2. Select 2 prints from the stack. Cut them into a graduated set of flowers, moving from largest to smallest and leaving each one with a large hole in the center. Embellish each one with the self-adhesive pearls and then slide them in place onto the tree form, largest on the bottom going to the smallest on the top.
3. Wrap the pearl and lace ribbon 2-3 times around the top of the tree. Tie it off in a bow at the bottom of the skewer.
4. Cut 2 angel shapes using the gold glitter cardstock. Each angel will need to be cut opposite of each other. Adhere them to the top of the tree, sandwiching the skewer in the middle.
