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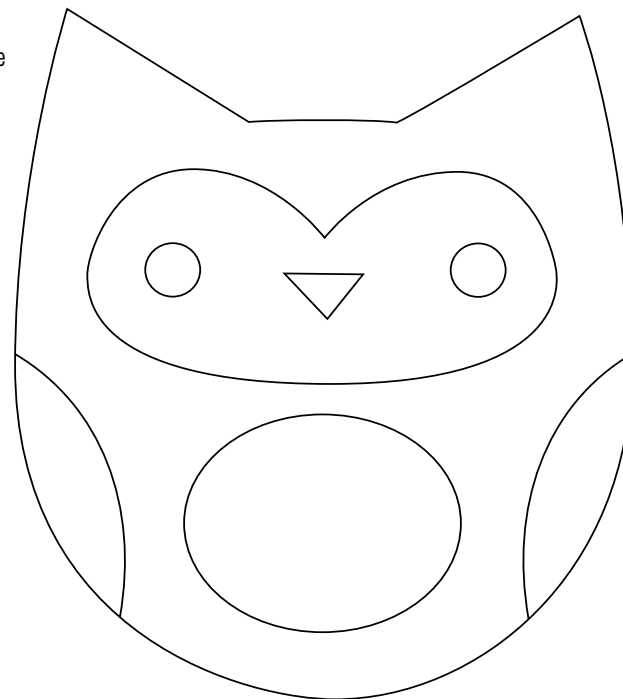
Sew with Jo-Ann

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Fleece: 2/3 yd body; 12"x6" mask; 7"x8" belly; 4"x4" eyes & beak
- 1/4 yd woven fusible interfacing: cut two 4"x7" pcs
- 1/2 yd Pellon[®] Wonder-Under[®] Fusible Web
- Sewing machine & basic sewing supplies
- 1 bag polyester stuffing
- Thread
- Iron, pressing surface & cloth

DIRECTIONS: All seam allowances are 1/2". RS=Right sides. WS= Wrong sides.

1. Enlarge pattern to 14 1/2" wide. Cut two body fleece pieces using pattern plus 1/2" seam allowance.
2. Place fusible web paper-side up on pattern. Trace the mask, belly, eyes & beak. Cut wide around the drawn pattern pieces. Fuse on the back of fabric following manufacturer's directions. Cut out fleece on drawn lines.
3. Fuse fleece pieces to front of one body piece using pressing cloth.
4. Straight stitch 1/8" in from edges around mask, eyes, beak & belly.
5. Fuse interfacing on back side of fabric where wing lines will be sewn. Mark for wings; sew line with satin stitch.
6. Pin RS front & back of body of pillow fabric together. Sew around edge leaving 4" open. Clip fabric at points & around the curves, turn RS out through opening; gently push ears out.
7. Fill the pillow with polyester stuffing. Hand stitch closed with a slip stitch.
